François Ruegg is Emeritus/Honorary Professor at the Institute of Social Anthropology, University of Fribourg (Switzerland) and Permanent Invited Professor at the University of Bucharest (Romania), UNESCO Chair. Docteur d'Etat ès Lettres et Sciences Humaines (Ethnology) of the University Paul Valéry of Montpellier (France), he is a specialist in Eastern and Central European Studies.



He has searched, taught and published on a variety of topics such as the built environment, intercultural, interethnic, interreligious relations, historical anthropology, social representations and religious anthropology. He also lectured at the Universities of Timisoara and Cluj in Romania, the New University of Bulgaria in Sofia, as well as at Gumilev Eurasian University in Astana, Kazakhstan. He was the Founder and President of Pro Ethnographi©a, an association devoted to valorise ethnographic collections inherited from Missionary Ethnology professors at the University of Fribourg. He is a member of the editorial Board of the series "Fribourg Studies in Social Anthropology" and serves as an expert for the Fund for Scientific Research in Belgium (F.R.S./FNRS).
