





# Inter-institutional agreement 2019/2020 - 2020/211

Higher Education Student and Staff Mobility - Mobility for learners and staff

The institutions named below agree to cooperate for the exchange of students and/or staff in the context of the Erasmus+ programme. This inter-institutional agreement will come into effect only if both institutions are holders of a valid Erasmus Charter for Higher Education and they commit to respect the quality requirements of the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education in all aspects related to the organisation and management of the mobility, in particular the recognition of the credits awarded to students by the partner institution.

#### A. Information about higher education institutions

At the University of Messina and the Universidad San Jorge all Erasmus agreements are signed and handled on a faculty or departmental level. - 2. The receiving institution will send its decision within 8 weeks after deadline.
- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
- 4. Termination of the Agreement or changes in the data set above should be made by written notification before **January 1**<sup>st</sup> for the following academic year. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.

Code of Studies and Examinations: Section 48. (1) Assessment of student performance can be carried out according to:

- a) a five-grade scale: excellent (5), good (4), satisfactory (3), pass (2), fail (1),
- b) a three-grade scale: excellent (5), satisfactory (3), fail (1). (2)162 The student shall not earn credit points in case his/her performance is assessed by fail (1) in the five-grade scale and fail (1) in the three-grade scale, further, if the performance of the student could not be assessed and in the academic records the note 'not completed' is registered
