- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution **no later than 6** weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.

#### F. Information

#### 1. Grading systems of the institutions

**University of Granada grading system:** In the Spanish university system, each course unit is graded on a scale from 0 to 10 points, and each numerical grade corresponds to a qualitative grade as follows: Suspenso (Fail): 0- 4.9 - Aprobado (Pass): 5- 6.9 - Notable (Good): 7- 8.9 - Sobresaliente (Very Good): 9- 10 - Matrícula de Honor: A special mention for outstanding performance limited to a maximum of 5% of students registered in a given course unit group. When a student does not take the corresponding examination or final assessment, this is reflected as No Presentado (Absent). To pass a course unit, a student must receive a grade of at least 5 points out of 10.
