E MURCIA01:

The University of Murcia will not be able to accept incoming students from subject areas not covered by this bilateral agreement. However, students can enroll in any extra subject from other subject areas provided that: 1) they do not represent the majority of the Learning Agreement, 2) the academic advisor is in agreement with the Learning Agreement prior to the arrival of the student. Furthermore, we will only be able to accept students for Master degrees if the bilateral agreement includes this level.

There is only one application deadline for students in the areas of Medicine, Pharmacy, Dentistry and Physiotherapy. These areas are taken at the Faculty of Medicine which has its own admission procedure as follows:

- Signed Learning Agreements will be returned before the 30th June.
- Once the applicant receives confirmation of acceptance of the Learning Agreement he/she should register in http://erasmus.um.es by the 30th June.

The University of Murcia has adapted its facilities in order to allow access to people with disabilities. - 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the University of Murcia as receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
- 4. Termination of the agreement

The inter-institutional agreement may be amended by mutual agreement. The inter-institutional agreement may be terminated by either party. In the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. In the event of such notice being given, all existing commitments to staff or students will be fulfilled. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.
