D. Additional requirements

Service for students and staff with disabilities

P LISBOA03:

- The academic year at NOVA FCSH usually runs from September to January (1- semester) and from February to June (2- semester).
 - The period of student mobility can only be testified according to our academic calendar: maximum of 4 or 5 months for one semester and 9 months for full academic year.
- NOVA FCSH organizes biannual courses of Portuguese Language and Culture for foreigners.
 Attendance is strongly recommended and at no cost for all incoming students of NOVA FCSH.

Exchange students at NOVA FCSH can sign up for a maximum of 30 ECTS per semester (plus 4 ECTS for the Portuguese Language Course) and must attend at least one course per semester in one of the Departments that have the Erasmus+ Agreement with the partner university. The remaining courses can be chosen among our entire academic offer.

 Students should highlight any disabilities at application stage so that their needs and requirements can be addressed and the right support assured prior to their acceptance. - 2. The receiving institution will send its decision within 4 weeks.
- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 4 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI. [It should normally not exceed five weeks according to the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education guidelines]
- 4. Termination of the agreement

In the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."
