

Inter-institutional agreement 2017/18 - 2020/211

Higher Education Student and Staff Mobility - Mobility for learners and staff

The institutions named below agree to cooperate for the exchange of students and/or staff in the context of the Erasmus+ programme. This inter-institutional agreement will come into effect only if both institutions are holders of a valid Erasmus Charter for Higher Education and they commit to respect the quality requirements of the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education in all aspects related to the organisation and management of the mobility, in particular the recognition of the credits awarded to students by the partner institution.

A. Information about higher education institutions

At the Babeş-Bolyai University and at the Messina University, all Erasmus agreements are signed and handled on a faculty or departmental level. Faculties and departments are responsible for its own Erasmus agreements and exchanges. Incoming exchange students can only study courses within the partner faculty unless otherwise agreed.

- 2. The receiving institution will send its decision within 8 weeks after deadline.
- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
- 4. Termination of the Agreement or changes in the data set above should be made by written notification before **January 1**st for the following academic year. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.

- 4 FAIL some more work required before the credit can be awarded
- 1, 2, 3 FAIL considerable further work is required
