3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving Institution no later than 12 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.

4. Termination of the agreement

This Collaboration Agreement may be terminated on the following grounds:

- End of stipulated period of validity.
- Mutual agreement between the parties.
- Written notice of termination with 6 months in advance, provided the termination shall not become effective until the end of the stay of the students enrolled in both institutions on the date of notification.



