

- 3. E BURGOS01: A **Transcript of Records** will be issued by the University of Burgos no later than **6 weeks** after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI
- 4. Termination of Agreement: The parties may terminate of modify the agreement before the agreed academic year. In the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.

Are there any restrictions for Erasmus students when it comes to course selection? Are Erasmus students allowed to sign up for courses outside the subject area of the exchange agreement?

Erasmus students are required to enroll, at least, in one course in the School/Department/Subject area of the agreement. If the courses differ very much from the area included in the agreement, this has to be consulted with the School but E BURGOS is very flexible in allowing Erasmus students to take courses from other departments.
