

"STUDENTS AROUND THE WORLD" (SAW) CALL FOR SCHOLARSHIPS FOR UNIME STUDENTS FOR STUDY AT THE EXTRA-EUROPEAN UNIVERSITIES IN THE CONTEXT OF INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION AGREEMENTS – 2024 edition

WHO: Undergraduate and graduate students enrolled at UniME

WHEN: A.Y. 2023/24 – 2024/25

DURATION: minimum 3 months (and 12 ECTS per semester), maximum 12 months
minimum 1 month (and 5 ECTS), maximum 2 months RESERVED ONLY for Practical Evaluation Internship (Tirocinio Pratico Valutativo -TPV) in the “Medicine and Surgery” and “Medicina e Chirurgia” Degree Courses

WHERE: Partner universities outside Europe

HOW to apply:

1. Students who are interested in participating should send their application via UniME ESSE3 (<https://unime.esse3.cineca.it>) through:

- Login with SPID for adult Italian candidates;
- Login without SPID for minors and foreign citizens.

The selection procedure will be active for 30 days starting from the day following the online publication of the Call for Applications in the University Register at the address: <http://www.unime.it/it/ateneo/amministrazione/albo-online>

2. The application must include the following documents (all the forms are available at the following link (<https://www.unime.it/bandi/bando-students-around-world-saw>):

- Learning Agreement for Studies or Learning Agreement for Traineeships, correctly filled out and signed by the student, Referent for International Mobility from student’s Degree Course/Commission for international mobility from student’s Department and - if possible (strongly recommended) - the Referent for international Mobility for the hosting University;
- document attesting linguistic competence, if required by the Host Institution, or self-certification (art. 9 of the Call);
- participation in previous mobility periods under the Erasmus programme or other international mobility programmes;
- ISEEU certificate of income, ONLY for students who have not presented it at the time of annual enrolment at UniME and for which therefore it is not deduced from ESSE 3 system. ISEEU can be asked to an authorised C.A.F. office. In order to obtain it, you need to bring the Family or Personal Income Statement that you received from the Italian Embassy to the C.A.F. office. This document is not mandatory but will determine the amount of your scholarship. In absence, your scholarship will be set at the minimum level (€500/month).

Applications with missing documents will be excluded.

SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT: Min. €500/month, max. €950/month plus a one off extra contribution for the flight ticket.
